4. According to Stone, what impact does *Natural Born Killers* have on audiences? What impact does he say television has on viewers?
5. In 3-4 sentences. Explain your beliefs about the connection between television/movie violence and social (real life) violence. How much power do films/tv have to encourage someone to do something he or she would not normally do? How much responsibility should film-makers, writers and directors take? Use examples in your explanation.
